Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 8/20/18
With two sessions of NWEA assessments this week and a convocation squeezing in everything else will be a challenge.

Reading- Theme: Trading with one another. Main Selection: What about Me? (Fable), Paired Selection: How the Desert Tortoise Got Its Shell (Myth)
3rl2.3, 3rl2.2, 3rf4 We will work on sequencing and summarizing. Students will also study compound words and how $A B C$ order is used in reference books like dictionaries, glossaries, and indexes. In addition to reading from the "book" the students will read from extra readers, and from their own books chosen for silent reading. We will work on writing answers in complete sentences. We will be starting some small group work. Assessment: At the end of the week the students will take a weekly assessment over the skills covered. Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are emphasized every week. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5, 3rf1, 3w2.1, 3rf5, 3rf4)

English $-3 w 6.2 a, 3 w 6 b, 3 w 6.1 e, 3 w 3.2$ Students will be improving sentence writing skills by answering questions in complete sentences. Identifying types of sentences and using correct end punctuation. Writing informative paragraphs using facts and details. Assessment: Grades will come from daily assignments and possibly a quiz this week.

Spelling 3w6.2c, $3 r f 4.5$ Phonics/Spelling: List 2: Short Vowels, plurals with -s, -es, and -ies. Students will complete a few activities throughout the week to study these words in different ways. Assessment: The trial test will be on Thursday. If the student makes a $100 \%$ on all list words there is no need to take the test on Friday. There are two bonus words. These make it possible to earn a $102 \%$ on the test.

Math - 3at4, 3at2, 3c2 Hoping to get three lessons from Topic 1 completed this week. They will connect multiplication with a number line, repeated addition, and arrays. Practice pages may come home as homework.
Multiplication monsters: 3c2, 3c5, 3c6 The students continue to progress with one-minute tests. Assessment: Friday's multiplication test will be over twos.

Social Studies - 3.3.1, 3.3.2, 3.3.3, 3.3.4, 3.3.8 Students will be studying the Midwest, identifying the states, rivers, lands, and the Great Lakes. They will continue using cardinal and intermediate directions. . Assessment: Students will be graded on assignments and oral participation.
