## Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 8/27/18

## NWEA Language Arts assessment this Tuesday

Reading- Reading- Theme: How Can We Achieve Goals?

Main Selection: <u>Kumak's Fish</u> p.98-113 (Tall Tale) Paired Selection: <u>How to Catch a Fisher p.118-119 (Newspaper Article)</u> 3rl1.4.2, 3rv2, 3rl1.2, 3rv2.5, The skills emphasized will be visualizing, sequencing, understanding unknown words, and using a dictionary. In addition to reading from the "book" the students will read from other extra readers, and from their own books chosen for silent reading. They will be reading from the Scholastic News magazine completing activities over a variety of skills. We will work on writing answers in complete sentences. (Restating the question in the answer.) **Assessment**: At the end of the week the students will take a weekly assessment over the skills covered.

Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are emphasized every week. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5, 3rf1, 3w2.1, 3rf5, 3rf4)

**English** -3w6.2a, 3w6b, 3w6.1e, 3w3.2 Students will be improving sentence writing skills by answering questions in complete sentences. Identifying types of sentences and using correct end punctuation. Writing informative paragraphs using facts and details. **Assessment**: Grades will come from daily assignments and possibly a quiz on Wednesday over sentence punctuation and using complete sentences.

**Spelling** 3w6.2c, 3rf4.4 Phonics/Spelling: List 3: Short Vowels: base words and endings - ed, -ing, -er, -est Students will complete a few activities throughout the week to study these words in different ways. **Assessment:** The trial test will be on Thursday. If the student makes a 100% on all list words there is no need to take the test on Friday. There are two bonus words. These make it possible to earn a 102% on the test.

Math - 3c3, 3c4, 3at4, 3at2 Planning to cover lessons 1-5 through 1-7, then review for and give the Topic 1 test. This is the first Topic test of the year and it will be a paper/pencil form instead of on the computer. The students will berecognizing division as sharing and repeated subtraction. Reteaching pages will come home on Thursday for review. Practice pages may come home as homework.

Multiplication monsters: 3c2, 3c5, 3c6 The students continue to progress with one-minute tests. **Assessment: Topic** 1 book assessment on Friday. Friday's multiplication test will be over fives.

Social Studies/Science - 3.3.1, 3.3.2, 3.3.3, 3.3.4, 3.3.8 Students will be completing and labeling some Midwest maps, identifying the states, rivers, lands, and the Great Lakes. They will continue using cardinal and intermediate directions. 3ps1, 3ps2 Hope to begin science later in the week starting with "Chapter 1: Forces and Motion" in our new Science series.

Assessment: Students will be graded on assignments and oral participation.
