Fisher's 3rd grade Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 9/4/18 -

In **Reading** are finishing up last week's skills and will test take the weekly assessments on Tuesday. This is partly due to Labor Day and then to other interruptions. **Reading**- Unit 1 Week 5 Theme: What Do We Need to Know about Spending and Saving? Main Selection: <u>My Rows and Piles of Coins p.168-183</u> (Realistic Fiction) Paired Selection: <u>Learning about Money (Web Sites)</u>

3rl2.3, 3rl3, 3rv2.4, 3w3.1 We will work on identifying the author's purpose when writing. We will write for different purposes. The students will recognize how words are built from base words with prefixes and suffixes added. In addition to reading from the "book" the students will read from other extra readers, and from their own books chosen for silent reading. They will be reading from the Scholastic News magazine completing activities over a variety of skills. **Assessment**: At the end of the week (carrying over to Monday) the students will take a weekly assessment over the skills covered.

Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are emphasized every week. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5, 3rf1, 3w2.1, 3rf5, 3rf4)

English - 3w3.2, 3w6.1, 3w6.2 Students continue to improve individual sentence writing skills by answering questions in complete sentences, and identifying fragments and complete sentences. They will identify subjects and predicates. Students will use paragraph writing skills to write story summaries. **Assessment**: Grades will come from daily assignments and possibly a quiz.

Spelling 3w6.2, 3rf4.4, 3rv2 List 5: vowel diphthongs of ow, ou, oy, and oi. The students will complete a few activities throughout the week to study these words in different ways. **Assessment:** The trial test will be on Thursday. If the student makes a 100% on all list words there is no need to take the test on Friday. There are two bonus words. These make it possible to earn a 102% on the test.

Math - 3c2, 3at4, 3at2 Continuing in Topic 2, covering lessons 2-2 and 2-5 (went out of order). The students will work on multiplication facts (0, 1, 2, 5, 9, 10). Homework practice pages from the textbook may come home as homework.

Multiplication monsters: 3c2, 3c5, 3c6 The students continue to progress with oneminute tests. This is the scheduled 3's week. Things get tougher from here on. We practice during the week but further studying may be required. **Assessment:** Lesson Reviews may will be used as quiz grades. Topic 2 Assessment on Thursday (both paper and online versions) Friday's multiplication test will be over threes.

Science - 3.5e2, 3.5e3 "The Nature of Science" continues. Students will identify the types of questions scientists ask, observe, predict, measure and interpret data. It's the scientific process. **Assessment**: Students will be graded on lesson assignments, completion of activities and oral participation.
