## Fisher's 3rd grade Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 9/17/18 -

In **Reading** on Monday, students will take the U1Week 5 tests. Still playing catchup. Also, there's a field trip this Friday.

Reading- Unit 1 Review week- (standards are from the previous five weeks) This is our Unit Review week. We are reviewing vocabulary using skill pages and Spellingcity.com. We are studying any and all skills covered in Unit 1 that might appear on the Unit One Benchmark test that will be taken online Wednesday. We will read more current events and complete another Scholastic Geography Spin this week. Assessment: Students will take a Unit Vocabulary test (paper copy) and the Unit 1 Benchmark assessment on the Pearson Realize website. Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are emphasized every week. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5, 3rf1, 3w2.1, 3rf5, 3rf4)

English - 3w3.2, 3w6.1, 3w6.2 Students continue to improve individual writing skills by answering questions in complete sentences, identifying and correcting fragments and writing detailed complete sentences. They are identifying subjects and predicates. Students will use paragraph writing skills to write story summaries. Assessment: Grades will come from daily assignments and possibly a quiz.

Phonics/Spelling 3w6.2, 3rf4.4, 3rv2 List 6: Review List. This fifty word list has ten words each from the previous 5 spelling lists. The ONLY test will be on Thursday. Because all ten bonus words are included there is the opportunity to score as high as a 110% and I'm sure a few students will. Assessment: The trial test will be on Thursday. If the student makes a 100% on all list words there is no need to take the test on Friday. There are two bonus words. These make it possible to earn a 102% on the test.

Math - 3c1, 3da1, The students took the online Topic 2 assessment Monday. They'll compare that result to the paper pencil copy last week and use the better grade. Instead of going into Topic 3 we will move to Topic 7 and then return to Topic 3. The students will use graphs to compare and interpret data. They'll use a variety of graphs, charts, and tables.

Multiplication monsters: 3c2, 3c5, 3c6 The students continue to progress with one-minute tests. This is the scheduled 4's week. We practice during the week but further studying may be required. **Assessment:** Lesson Reviews may will be used as quiz grades. Friday's multiplication test will be over fours.

Science - 3.5e2, 3.5e3 "The Nature of Science" continues. Students will conduct an investigation, gather information and communicate results and learn about some basic scientific tools. They'll still identify the types of questions scientists ask, observe, predict, measure and interpret data. It's the scientific process. Assessment: Students will be graded on lesson assignments, completion of activities and oral participation.
