Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 8/6/18

Reading- Introduction Week

Reading- We won't start a unit in the book until next year. I will spend this week getting to know your child and how they read. They will spend this week getting to know me and getting back into the school routine. Students will take the Pearson Baseline test. Then we will read from a variety of materials. We will read about sunflowers and watermelons for fun. Next week, we will hit the reading series.

English – We will start our Daily Language review and our daily writing this week. Students will be given a question to answer. Hopefully, they will answer in a paragraph. Next week we will add a grammar skill.

Phonics/Spelling: We are using a "Beginning of the Year" review spelling list. Students will be practicing at school, using the words in sentences, and using the Spelling City website to practice. The pretest will be on Thursday and the final test will be on Friday.

Math - The students will take the baseline math assessment that goes with the math series. This new series was new last year and is challenging but the state standards are tough. It will take all of us a while to get used to it. This week lessons will cover place value and number sense. We will start multiplication NEXT WEEK!

Social Studies – We will begin the year studying the compass rose, map keys, continents and oceans. The students will be tested over this later next week with a quiz. Given the names of the continents and oceans they will locate and label.
