

Fisher's 3rd grade Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 11/26/18

Reading - Unit 3 Week 2 The skills being emphasized are understanding and recognizing the **literary elements** in a selection. These elements are setting, plot, and characters. This will be covered with daily activities and assignments. A dictionary will be used to find the meaning of words. (3.RL.3.1, 3.RL.2.3, 3.RV.2.1, 3.RV.2.5)

We will read from a variety of materials including selections from the reading series and the extra readers that support the same skills and vocabulary (3.RV.1, 3.RV.2.1). We will read and complete a "Scholastic News" magazine. *Little House in the Big Woods*- We are hitting the novel full force this week. The students may have some "at home" reading assignments. We will focus on the vocabulary associated with the book not the weekly story.

Book Talks 3sl3, 3sl4 - This is the last week for the November books. Students may present their book talks this week or Monday, December 3rd. **Assessment:** At the end of the week the students will take weekly assessments over the comprehension skills covered. Grades may be taken off of LH questions and/or vocabulary activities.

English - 3w1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4 Students will focus on narrative writing starting with personal narratives. Students will write sentences with the spelling words which show understanding of the words' meanings and shows correct subject verb agreement. Students will use paragraph writing skills to write chapter summaries from the class novel. **Assessment:** Grades will come from daily writing assignments and spelling sentences.

Spelling/Phonics 3w6.2, 3rf4, 3rv2, List 14: Prefixes (un-, re-, mis-, dis-) 3RF.4.6 We will complete assignments about the spelling pattern and about the word meanings during the week. The tests will be Thursday and Friday. **Assessment:** If the student makes a 100% on all 20 list words on Thursday, there is no need to take the test on Friday.

Math - 3at1, 3at3, 3c1, 3ns9 - Students will begin Topic 8: *Using Strategies and Properties to Add and Subtract*. This may seem like an easier topic but it has proven not to be in the past. Students will need to regroup correctly. It is an easily forgotten skill, especially in subtraction when subtracting from zeros. The students will add and round numbers this week.

Division: 3c3, 3c4, 3c5, 3c6 The students have started division and intend to slay the Division Dragon. The one minute tests will begin with 0/1 similar to the multiplication sequence. Then go 2, 5, 10, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, mixed. This is Zero and One Week for practice. 3m3 **Assessment:** 'Lesson Review' pages may be used as quiz grades. Friday's computation test will be over 0/1 division.

Science - We are finish Chapter 6: Weather in Science. (3.ESS.1, 3.ESS.2) over the water cycle, measuring weather, and recognizing extreme weather dangers. **Assessment:** Assignments will come from daily assignments and/or quizzes. There will be a test by then end of the week. A study guide will come home the night prior.
