## Fisher's 3<sup>rd</sup> grade Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 12/10/18

**Reading** - Unit 3 Week 2 (continued) The skills being emphasized comprehension, homophones, and multiple meanings. The students will be looking up answers in text then answering questions completely. They will recognize and use identified homophones correctly. They identify which meaning of a word is being used. This will be covered with daily activities and assignments. (3rn2.1, 3rn3.1, 3rn3.3, 3.RV.2.1, 3.RV.2.4, 3rv.2.5)

We will read from a variety of materials including selections from the reading series and the extra readers that support the same skills and vocabulary (3.RV.1, 3.RV.2.1). We will read and complete a "Scholastic News" magazine. *Little House in the Big Woods-* We should read through chapter 4 or 5 this week. The students will have vocabulary quizzes on Tuesday over chapters 1&2, then later in the week over Chapters 3&4. The students may have some "at home" reading assignments.

Book Talks 3s13, 3s14 - The next book talk will be in January.

English - 3w1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4 Students continue to focus on narrative writing starting with personal narratives. Students will write sentences with the spelling words which show understanding of the words' meanings and shows correct subject verb agreement. Students will use paragraph writing skills to write chapter summaries from the class novel. Assessment: Grades will come from daily writing assignments and spelling sentences.

Spelling/Phonics: List 15: sounds of /j/, /s/, and /k/ 3w6.2, 3rf4, 3rv2, List 1We will complete assignments over the spelling of the words and about the word meanings during the week. The tests will be Thursday and Friday. Assessment: If the student makes a 100% on all 20 list words on Thursday, there is no need to take the test on Friday.

Math - 3c1, 3ns9, 3at1 - Students will continue with Topic 8: Using Strategies and Properties to Add and Subtract. Applying the "properties" isn't easy. Students are using mental math strategies to add and subtract. They will estimate both sums and differences, relating addition to subtraction. The goal is to get the Topic 8 assessment in before Christmas break. Looks like we will take it on Wednesday, the 19<sup>th</sup>.

Division: 3c3, 3c4, 3c5, 3c6 The students have started division and intend to slay the Division Dragon. This is Fives/Tens Week for practice. 3m3 Assessment: 'Lesson Review' pages may be used as guiz grades. Friday's computation test will be over 2 division.

Science - After some struggles with technical difficulties the Weather Show turned out really nice. Kids were naturals on camera. Not sure yet how we can share it out to parents. We are studying the Native American Woodland Indians who lived in this region. We are studying several different tribes. Then we will discuss Lewis and Clark and do a quick study of Sacagawea (not the Disney version) (3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.8)

Assessment: Assignments will come from daily assignments and/or quizzes.
