Fisher's 3rd grade Weekly Lesson Plan Summary for 1/14/19

Reading - Unit 3 Week 5 This week emphasis will be on cause and effect, making predictions, and word structure. Students will recognize a cause and the effect it has by finding it in a passage. They will make predictions then read to determine if the prediction was correct. (3rn3.2, 3rn1, 3rn2.3, 3rv2.4) We will read and complete a "Scholastic News" magazine. *Little House in the Big Woods-* We should finish the novel this week. The students will have a vocabulary quiz over Chapters 8-10 Wednesday and later in the week and there will a test over all the vocabulary for the book. Also, coming home will be end of book projects that will be due on the 23rd and 24th. **Book Talks** <u>3sl3</u>, <u>3sl4</u> - It's the half way point of the month. Hopefully, the students are at least half way through their books for the month of January.

English – <u>3w1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4</u> Students continue to focus on narrative writing starting with personal narratives. We will study the newly created narrative "rubric" based on the skills assessed on the upcoming ILEARN. Students will write sentences with the spelling words which show understanding of the words' meanings and shows correct subject verb agreement. **Grammar -3w6.1b** Students will be identifying and using action verbs this week. **Assessment**: Grades will come from daily writing assignments and spelling sentences.

Phonics/Spelling: List 17 consonant patterns 3RF4.2. The students should recognize the consonant patters and apply these patterns when spelling and decoding words. We will practice at school, completing a variety of activities. <u>3w6.2</u>, <u>3rf4</u>, <u>3rv2</u>. We will complete assignments over the spelling of the words and about the word meanings during the week. The tests will be Thursday and Friday. **Assessment**: If the student makes a 100% on all 20 list words on Thursday, there is no need to take the test on Friday.

Math - 3c1, 3at1 - We are working from Topic 9: Fluently Add and Subtract within 1,000. Students will be learning about standard procedures for adding and subtracting. The lessons will break apart numbers, using place value, to add and subtract. The Topic 9 test should be next week.

Division: <u>3c3</u>, <u>3c4</u>, <u>3c5</u>, <u>3c6</u>. The students have started division and intend to slay the Division Dragon. This is Threes Week for practice. 3m3 **Assessment**: On Friday they should be ready for a test over these lessons. 'Lesson Review' pages may be used as quiz grades. Friday's computation test will be over 3 division.

Social Studies/ Science - The students are studying from Chapters 1 and 2 "Forces and Motion" and "Forms of Energy". We will focus on sound energy because that is emphasized in the Indiana standards. (3PS1-PS4) **Assessment**: Graces will come from daily assignments and/or quizzes.
