Unit 4 Week Unit 4 Review week

This week the students will be reviewing a variety of skills in order to complete the Unit 4 Benchmark test planned for Thursday. This will also help prepare for ALL those upcoming assessments. Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are always emphasized. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5) We will try meeting with reading groups. We will read from a variety of materials. We will try to read and complete a "Scholastic News" magazine if time allows. The students will read it independently and watch the related videos on the website.

Book Talks-The students have been picking out March books. It's the last month! It isn't too late to give the February Book Talk. It is much better to lose 20 points that to earn a zero. Assessment- The students will complete a benchmark test for Unit 4. They will also complete a Unit 4 vocabulary test. These will be on Thursday and/or Friday. Some grades may come from the Vocabularycity.com and or daily assignments.

English/Writing With all the writing it has been hard to get in many grammar lessons. We are opinion writing this week and completing another reading comprehension/writing (typing) prompt this week. 3s1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4. Students will also write sentences which show understanding of the words' meanings and shows correct subject verb agreement, using the spelling words.

<u>Assessment</u>: Grades may come from writing, spelling sentences, and practice pages.

Phonics/Spelling: List 24- 50-word review test (3.rf.4.2, 3rf4.6, 3w6.2d) The students will practice this week. They will take and grade together a test over the first half and then the second half of the words so each will know how to study. Friday will be the only test for a grade. There is a chance to score 110% and I am sure someone will. Assessment: The student will be graded on Friday's test.

Math - (3ns8, 3ns3, 3ns7, and 3g2) - We will complete Topic 13: Fraction Equivalence and Comparison test on Wednesday. The students will bring home a study guide Tuesday. Then we will move to topic 15 over geometry. (We have already completed some of 14.) Students will describe quadrilaterals and classify shapes based on a variety of attributes. Assessment: Topic test on Wednesday and possibly "review" quiz over previous topics.

Computation: 3c1 Students will practice 3-digit addition and subtraction, with and without regrouping this week. Assessment: Friday's computation quiz will be a mixed test of 16 of these problems.

Division: 3c3, 3c4, 3c5, 3c6. We are finished with our weekly division tests but the students will continue on with their individual leveled 1 minute tests to build speed and accuracy, and earn dragon pars. Assessment: There may be a guiz over previous topics.

Social Studies/ Science - Most of our science and social studies this week will come from the "Scholastic News", "Geography Spin", and "Science Spin" magazines. Then the students will begin an economics unit. **Assessment**: Grades will come from daily assignments and/or quizzes.
