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Reading- We have begun Charlotte's Web. In fact, the entire 3rd grade is reading it. We should get through chapter 4 this week. There may be some at home reading assignments. If so, the students will have a bookmark for a parent signature. There will be three vocabulary tests throughout but not one this week. The students will have some writing assignments related to the book. Please DO NOT allow them to watch the videos now. It is best they visualize the story as the author intended. The movies don't necessarily follow along and they may miss some answers to questions. Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are always emphasize d. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5) We will try to catch up on the "Scholastic News" magazines, "Geo Spins", and "Science Spins".

Book Talks- This is the LAST week to present the book talks. It's the last month! Assessment- The students will complete chapter questions, vocabulary activities, and/or a weekly skills assessment this week. Some grades may come from the Vocabularycity.com and or daily assignments.

English/Writing We are writing a narrative piece from a character's perspective that relates to the novel we are reading. <u>3s1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4</u>. Students will also write sentences which show understanding of the words' meanings and shows correct subject verb agreement, using the spelling words. <u>Assessment</u>: Grades may come from writing, spelling sentences, and practice pages.

Phonics/Spelling: List 26: Homophones (3.w.6.2c, 3.rf.4.2) After the students practice and study the words, the tests will be on Thursday and Friday. This will be especially tricky because they will have to listen carefully to how the word is used in the sentence. **Assessment**: If the student makes a 100% on list words on Thursday, there is no need to take the test on Friday.

Math - (3m3) - We have begun chapter 14 over measurement. There will be no topic test this week. It should be at the beginning of next week. The students will measure time to the minute and elapsed time. They will estimate and measure liquid and mass. **Assessment**: There will likely be a quiz during the week over previously covered topics.

Computation: <u>3c1</u> Students will work on 3-digit subtraction and 2-digit multiplication this week. **Assessment**: Friday's computation quiz will be over a previously learned skill

Social Studies/ Science – (3.ESS.3) The students are studying rocks and minerals. Observe the detailed characteristics of rocks and minerals. Identify and classify rocks as being composed of different combinations of minerals.
