Reading- Week #2 for Charlotte's Web. Hopefully, we get through chapter 9. After Chapter 9 there will be a vocabulary quiz. This will be early next week. There may be some at home reading assignments. If so, the students will have a bookmark for a parent signature. The students will have some writing assignments related to the book, answering comprehension questions and summarizing chapters. Please DO NOT allow them to watch the videos now. It is best they visualize the story as the author intended. The movies don't necessarily follow along and they may miss some answers to questions. Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are always emphasized. (3rn2.1, 3rn2.2, 3rn3.1, 3.rv2.4, 3.rv2.5)

We will try to catch up on the "Scholastic News" magazines, "Geo Spins", and "Science Spins".

Book Talks- No more book talks but I hope the students will continue to read. Studies show this is most important to increasing vocabulary and other literacy skills.

English/Writing Sneaking in some grammar with possessive pronouns and subject/verb agreement. 3s1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4. **Assessment:** Grades may come from writing, spelling sentences, and practice pages.

Phonics/Spelling: vowel patterns au, augh, ou, ough (3.rf4.2, 3w6.2) Since we aren't here Friday, after the students practice and study the words, the tests will be on Wednesday and Thursday.

Assessment: If the student makes a 100% on list words on Wednesday, there is no need to take the test on Thursday.

Math - (3m3) - We continue in chapter 14 over measurement. It was hoped there would be a topic test this week, but with the interruptions it will be next week. The students will measure capacity, mass and length. **Assessment:** There will likely be a quiz during the week over previously covered topics.

Computation: 3c1 Students will work mixed problems this week with some addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. **Assessment:** Friday's computation quiz will be over the mixed problems.

Social Studies/ Science - (3.ESS.3) The students are studying rocks and minerals. Observe the detailed characteristics of rocks and minerals. Identify and classify rocks as being composed of different combinations of minerals.
