**Reading- Charlotte's Web ends this week.** There will be one more vocabulary quiz. This will be on Wednesday over Chapters 18-22. The students will have some writing assignments related to the book. Fluency, vocabulary, handwriting, and comprehension are always emphasized.

**Assessment:** Weekly tests, vocabulary quiz

**English/Writing** Students will be working on letter writing. They will learn a format of a friendly letter and how to write letters for different purposes. We will mail each some letters. In preparation of addressing envelopes, students will learn their addresses. We will learn a consistent format that I'll type up using the most recent USPS format. I'll do this so I can grade it. 3s1, 3w6, 3w3.3, 3w4. **Assessment:** Grades may come from writing, spelling sentences, and practice pages.

**Phonics/Spelling:** List 30: Review list for 26-29 (3.rf4.2, 3w6.2) The students practice and review the words. We will take and grade a quiz over the first half on Wednesday and the second half on Thursday. The only test for a grade will be on Friday when they will be tested over all 60 words (ten bonus). Hopefully, a few students will score the possible 110%.

**Assessment:** The students will complete a spelling test on Friday.

**Math** - We are reviewing as many standards as possible to review. We will use a variety of materials and resources. The students will take a year-end test on Thursday. **Assessment:** There will likely be a quiz during the week over previously covered topics. Yearend test.

**Computation: 3c1** Students will work mixed problems this week with some addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. **Assessment:** Friday's computation quiz will be over the mixed problems.

**Social Studies/ Science** - (3.ESS.3, 3.3 Geography, 3.LS.1-4 ) The will move on to some geography and maps for Social Studies, completing an activity on maps of Central Elementary. We will finish the year off with plants. **Assessment:** quizzes, activities, and handouts
